

**Our cookie policy describes the types of cookies used by the [www.hygeo.it](http://www.hygeo.it) website (hereinafter, the website), the purposes of the cookies installed on your system and the ways in which you can select or deselect the cookies related to the services offered.**

## COOKIES

Cookies are small text files stored on your computer while you browse the web or use a web application.

These files contain information that contributes to enriching the functionality of a website (such as online purchases or customisation of advertisements based on your preferences). They collect statistical data and, broadly speaking, they improve your browsing experience.

### Type of cookies and purposes

There are different types of cookies which are classified according to their characteristics and scope, as explained in the following scheme:

#### Session cookies / Persistent cookies

Session cookies are temporarily stored in the computer's memory while visiting a site (for example, to remember the selected language).

Session cookies are stored for a short time and erased when you close the browser.

On the other hand, permanent cookies remain on your computer for a long time, depending on the expiry date set when the cookie is generated.

These cookies allow websites to retain information throughout all your subsequent visits. For instance, they permit you to log in without entering your credentials again.

**First-party cookies / Third-party cookies**

First-party cookies are set by the website you are visiting and are valid throughout the same domain shown in the browser's address bar. They can only be read by that specific website.

Third-party cookies, instead, are set by domains other than that indicated in the browser's address bar, that is, by entities that do not correspond to the owners of the website.

The cookies used to collect information for advertising purposes and content customisation, as well as to track visits to the site, may be defined as "third-party cookies".

**Technical cookies / Profiling cookies**

Technical cookies are essential for the proper operation of a website or application: if you disable them, the website may not function properly and certain functions might be unavailable.

Profiling cookies are used to collect and store information about you (such as the pages visited, the terms searched, etc.) in order to offer more targeted advertising messages in line with your interests.
